#### Note on 2026 Parish Acceptances

Parish acceptances for 2026 are based on *total revenue* rather than *operating revenue*, which has traditionally been the basis for calculating each parish's fair share. This change resulted from a recent update to the Parochial Report by the General Convention office, which removed operating revenue from the data collected.

In response, the Mission Support Office explored several ways to estimate acceptances that would stay as consistent as possible with previous years. However, because of this change in reporting, some inconsistencies remain from parish to parish and year to year. The General Convention office is aware of these challenges and is considering adjustments for the next reporting cycle.
